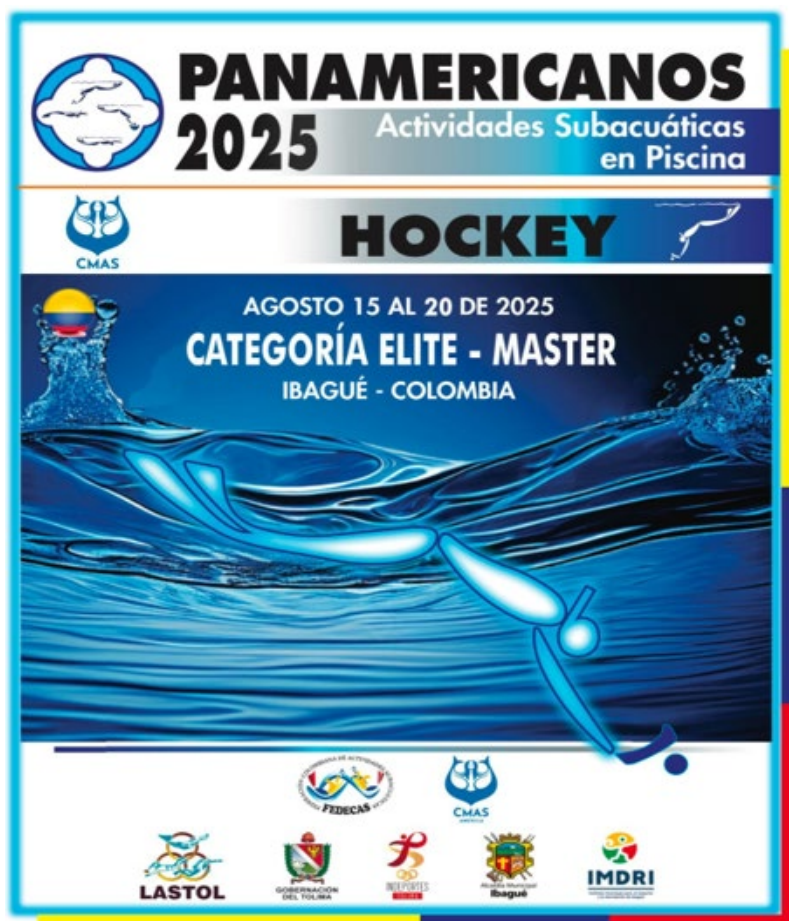

2.3. Eligibility

The championship is open to national teams from countries across the Americas. Participants must be affiliated with their respective national underwater hockey federations and comply with CMAS regulations.

2.4. Specific Rules

1.4.1 - 2025 CMAS 1st Intercontinental Championship Asia/Oceania Underwater Hockey.

- This tournament will be subject to all current rules for Category A tournaments as set out in the Regulations for Underwater Hockey Competitions Version 1.
- A copy of these regulations, which are expected to be approved by the CMAS BOD early February 2025.
- Player Eligibility is as per clause 1.4.1 of the regulations which are to be read in conjunction with the Eligibility Rule Determination that can be found at....
- These championships will be the qualifying competition for the 2027 CMAS World Championships Underwater Hockey.
- The actual number of qualifying slots for this tournament will be determined on 15th June 2025 and will be displayed on the CMAS Website.

3. General Information



3.1. Host City Location: Ibagué, Colombia

About Ibagué

Ibagué, known as the "Musical Capital of Colombia," is a vibrant and culturally rich city located in the central region of Colombia. Nestled in the Andean mountains at an elevation of approximately 1,285 meters (4,216 feet) above sea level, Ibagué enjoys a pleasant climate with average temperatures ranging from 18°C (64°F) to 28°C (82°F) throughout the year.

The city is famous for its musical heritage, hosting annual events like the Festival Folclórico Colombiano, which celebrates Colombian traditional music and dance. In addition to its musical traditions, Ibagué offers a variety of cultural, historical, and natural attractions. Visitors can explore its parks, museums, and nearby natural wonders, such as the Nevado del Tolima volcano and the Combeima Canyon.

3.2. Transportation to Ibagué

1. By Air

- **Perales Airport (IBE):** Ibagué is served by Perales Airport, which connects the city to Bogotá and other major Colombian cities. Direct flights from

Bogotá's El Dorado International Airport (BOG) to Ibagué take approximately 40 minutes.

- **International Travelers:** Most international travelers arrive in Colombia through Bogotá, Medellín, or Cali. From there, connecting flights to Ibagué are available.

2. By Road

- **From Bogotá:** Ibagué is approximately 200 km (124 miles) west of Bogotá. The drive takes about 4-5 hours by car or intercity bus, depending on traffic and weather conditions. The route passes through scenic mountain landscapes, making it an enjoyable journey.
- **From Medellín:** The distance from Medellín to Ibagué is about 260 km (162 miles), and the drive takes roughly 6-7 hours.

3. By Bus

- Ibagué has a well-connected bus terminal offering services from major Colombian cities. Bus companies provide frequent and affordable routes to the city.

3.3. Venue Details: Complejo Acuático - Parque Deportivo Ibagué

Overview



The Complejo Acuático at Parque Deportivo Ibagué is a state-of-the-art aquatic center designed to host national and international competitions. Inaugurated in September 2024, this facility has quickly become a central hub for aquatic sports in Colombia.

Pool Specifications

The complex features multiple pools tailored for various aquatic disciplines:

- **Competition Pool:** This Olympic-sized pool measures 50 meters in length and 25 meters in width, adhering to international standards for competitive swimming and underwater hockey. The depth is 3 meters, providing optimal conditions for underwater hockey matches.

- **Training Pool:** A secondary pool designed for warm-ups and practice sessions. It measures 25 meters in length and 20 meters in width, with a uniform depth of 2 meters.

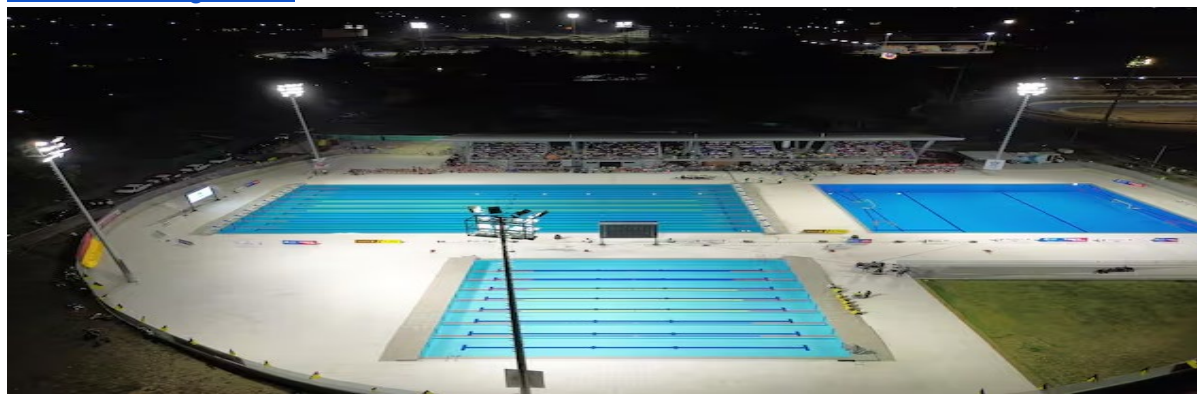
Facilities and Amenities

The aquatic center is equipped with modern amenities to ensure a comfortable experience for athletes and spectators:

- **Seating Capacity:** The venue can accommodate up to 1,500 spectators, offering clear views of the competition area.
- **Locker Rooms:** Separate facilities for male and female athletes, each equipped with showers, restrooms, and secure lockers.
- **Medical Facilities:** On-site medical room staffed with professionals to address any health concerns during events.
- **Accessibility:** The complex is designed to be accessible, with ramps and designated seating areas for individuals with disabilities.

3.4. Visa Requirements

General Information

Travellers visiting Colombia for tourism purposes, including participants and attendees of the 2025 CMAS Pan American Championship Underwater Hockey Elite and Masters, must comply with the country's visa regulations. Colombia exempts citizens of certain countries from obtaining a tourist visa for short stays (typically up to 90 days).

Visa-Exempt Countries

Citizens from the following countries do **not** require a tourist visa to enter Colombia for stays of up to 90 days:

- **Americas:** Argentina, Bahamas, Barbados, Belize, Bolivia, Brazil, Canada, Chile, Costa Rica, Dominica, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador, Guatemala, Guyana, Honduras, Jamaica, Mexico, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Saint Kitts and Nevis, Saint Lucia, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Suriname, Trinidad and Tobago, United States, Uruguay, Venezuela.

Recommendations

- **Advance Planning:** Initiate the visa application process well ahead of your intended travel dates to accommodate processing times.
- **Stay Informed:** Visa policies can change; always refer to official sources for the most current information.
- **Health Requirements:** Ensure compliance with any vaccination requirements, such as yellow fever vaccination, especially if arriving from certain countries or planning to visit specific regions within Colombia.

3.5. Additional Information

- **Language:** Spanish is the official language.
- **Currency:** Colombian Peso (COP). Dollar to COP varies between 1 USD corresponding between 3700 and 4400 COP
- **Climate:** In August, Ibagué experiences mild temperatures, averaging between 18°C (64°F) and 28°C (82°F) with 70% humidity.
- **Time Zone:** Colombia Time (COT), UTC -5.
- Colombia follows the left-hand drive cars and people drive on the right hand side of the road
- The metrical measure system is used in Colombia
- The standard electrical voltage in Colombia is 110 volts-60Hz. Plugs and outlets are Type A and B. Two flat parallel pins

4.3. Championship Puck

The British Sims Puck is the selected puck for the championship.

4.4. Tournament Divisions

The following grades are offered for this tournament and each National Federation can enter a maximum of one team per division.

The divisions are:

- Men's Elite
- Women's Elite
- Master's Men
- Master's Women

The minimum ages are:

Elite 18 years old before 3 August 2025

Master's Over 34 year old

All athletes must possess a valid CMAS license available from [CMAS Portal](#).

Player Selection and Replacement

Teams are limited to 12 players and must be selected before the submission of the team list and player profiles on the 19th of July 2025. Players may be replaced between the 19th of July and tournament registration on medical grounds only. This provision is to limit the increased workload on volunteer organisers.

4.5. Playing Cap and Swimsuit Approvals

These requests must be submitted to the Tournament Director by email before 31st March 2025, to: uw.h.approvals@sport.cmas.org Please use **Cap and Swimsuit Approval Request** in your email request subject line.

As per Clause 11.2.1

- All players of a team must wear identical bathing attire (cap, suit and/or rash vest and/or shirt), which may have an imprint of their flag or country.
- Each team must have two sets of identical bathing attire, one light in colour (when the team is using white sticks) and one dark in colour (when the team is using black sticks), and
- Both sets need Event Director approval prior to arrival at the competition.

Light Colours: White, Yellow, Light Blue, Light Grey, Orange.

Dark Colours: Black, Blue, Royal Blue, Navy Blue, Grey, Brown, Green, Red Cap

Numbers: To assist referees, cap numbers are limited to numbers between 1 and 15.

4.6. Additional Training Space Availability

Limited training space will be available prior to the competition. Teams interested in booking training sessions should contact the organizing committee in advance at uwhpan2025col@gmail.com

4.7. Registration Process and Meetings

Registration, documents check and delivery of accreditation will be undertaken at the swimming pool venue for all teams. The registration and meeting will take place at the pool venue on August 16, 2025.

4.8. Ceremonies

Opening Ceremony

The inauguration ceremony will take place on August 16, 2025, at the Complejo Acuático Ibagué at 6:30 PM.

Awards and Closing Ceremony

The awards ceremony will be held immediately following the final matches on August 20, 2025. Medals and trophies will be presented to the top teams in each division.

Post-Event Celebration

A post-event celebration is planned for the evening of August 20, 2025. Details will be announced closer to the event date.

5.2. Referees

Each team must supply one Level 3 water referee. The tournament needs 16 suitable water referees to successfully officiate 2 matches at once.

Penalty fee for non-supply of referee is 1st referee €3,000, 2nd referee €2,000 or 3rd referee €1,000 i.e. A country sending 2 teams and no referees then the non supply of referee levy is €5,000

All Referees must pass the referee in water beep test to be considered for assessment on the 16th of August during the referee fitness test

Referee Accommodation and Transfers

The cost of Accommodation, food and local transport for referees will be covered by the organizer during the length of the event, 15 th – 20th August 2024. Referees arriving earlier will bare the cost of accommodation

6. Team Entry Fees

6.1. Registration

Team managers will receive an email invite to join the Team Managers WhatsApp group.

6.2. CMAS Athlete Licenses and Profiles

All teams must register for the CMAS championship via the online CMAS administration system. <https://portal.cmas.org/>. Your Underwater Federation has the login codes and passwords. The first step is for athletes to create their individual profile and request acceptance from the Federation.

All athletes are required to have their valid CMAS licences in order to be able to enter into the competition area. Sports Licences requests must be applied for via the online CMAS administration system also.

6.3. Tournament Entry Fee

The early entry fee is set at \$3500 per team. The due date for entry fees is 1st April 2025.

The late entry fee is set at USD \$4.000 per team. No late entry will be accepted after the 1st of July 2025.

The team entry fee covers the following costs:

- Opening ceremony
- Pool for 1 training day and competition days
- Online transmission, broadband high speed internet connections brought to the pool sides for the online transmission (high speed broadband WIFI)
- LED panels at the pools
- volunteers' assistance throughout the World Championship
- underwater cameras and underwater sound system
- first aid, medical service presence
- anti-doping tests' costs
- Hydration refill station
- participation at the opening, closing ceremonies
- Post event party for 15 people per team. Additional persons cost USD 30/person
